

# **2016 LEGISLATIVE ROUND-UP**

The COPC and its 49 member organizations advocate for policy and systems change to secure the health and well-being of all of Washington's children and families.

In this state legislative session we are supporting the following bills and concepts:

## SUPPORT GREATER PHYSICAL ACTIVITY/EDUCATION FOR OUR YOUNG PEOPLE

- 1. HB 2669 (RICCELLI): Physical education is critical to establishing patterns of behavior that promote fitness and healthy lifestyles. Washington State needs to both strengthen current accountability standards for PE minutes per week as well as increase the weekly minutes to nationally-accepted standards.
- **2.** *HB 2664 (CODY):* While providing for exemptions from physical education class might be justified for high schoolers, such an exemption for K-8 really misses the point of the importance of physical education curriculum. This bill eliminates that specific waiver.
- **3. SB 6407 (FAIN):** Physical education and physical activity are two distinct concepts. This bill provides a minimum of 30 minutes a day for our youngest schoolkids the K-5 cohort.

### SUPPORT HEALTHY FOOD AND A HEALTHY FOOD SYSTEM

- **4.** *HB 2798 (ROBINSON):* Requires a warning about the dangerous health effects of excessive consumption of sugar-sweetened beverages.
- 5. FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF A STATEWIDE FOOD POLICY EFFORT
   The current Washington State Food Systems Roundtable is hard at work developing a 25-year plan to achieve a just and equitable food system. Any state legislative efforts need to build upon this strong initial foundation of work. COPC has been a strong partner of this work since its inception.

## SUPPORT THE "HEALTHIEST NEXT GENERATION" (HNG) BUDGET REQUEST

6. SUSTAIN CORE STAFFING

Governor Inslee is proposing **ongoing funds to the Department of Early Learning** and the Office for the Superintendent of Public Instruction **to sustain the three key HNG positions at these state agencies**.
