**Budget Highlights (outside of bills with fiscal impacts):**

- *Operating (House and Senate)*
  - \$1 million to maintain funding for the No Child Left Inside program to the State Parks
  - \$500,000 for Small Farm Direct Marketing
  - \$100,000 for Pupil Transportation study
- *Capitol (Senate; still awaiting House)*
  - \$3 million for Healthy Kids, Healthy Schools grant program
- *Transportation (House and Senate)*
  - Bike/Ped grant: \$25.9 million from both sides
  - Bike/Ped projects: \$16.2 million in House/\$11.9 million in Senate
  - Safe Routes to School grants: \$28.8 million from both sides
