### Operating Budget Priorities

- SNAP Incentives: 2.5 million (DOH)
- Food Waste Reduction: 500k (Ecology and 100k (Commerce)
- Food Policy Forum: 48k (Ag) and 100k (Conservation Commission)
- Hot Breakfast & Additional Food Options: 1.4 million (Corrections)
- Regional Markets Program: 500k (Ag)
- School Lunch Duration: 126k (OSPI)

### Capital Budget Priorities

- Healthy Kids, Healthy Schools: 3.25 million (OSPI)
- Youth Recreational projects: 5.88 million (Commerce)
- State Parks Preservation/Maintenance: 35.4 million (State Parks)
- WA Wildlife & Rec Program: 85 million (Recreation and Conservation Office)
- Youth Athletic Fund: 12 million (Recreation and Conservation Office)

### Active Transportation Priorities

- Bike & Pedestrian projects list: 27.755 million (DOT)
- Safe Routes to Schools projects: 25.992 million (DOT)
